School uniform

On days when pupils have PE, they should arrive in school uniform and change into their PE kit.

Flu vaccinations

Primary schools in Scotland have successfully supported the flu immunisation programme since 2014, and this year the programme is being extended to secondary school pupils. NHS Scotland are recommending all children receive their flu vaccine this year for three reasons:

- 1. Flu can be serious, even for healthy children.
- 2. To reduce the risk of children spreading flu to friends and family.
- 3. To help prevent the flu virus putting extra strain on our NHS services this winter.

The vaccine will be given at school, as a painless nasal (nose) spray by the local NHS team and the date for VHS is Monday 20th September. During vaccination, there will be strict infection prevention and control measures in place.
