Flu Vaccinations

The NHS will be visiting Viewforth HS on Monday 7th and Wednesday 16th of November to provide flu vaccinations to all pupils who wish them. Vaccination forms were distributed to all pupils earlier this team. These forms should not be returned to the school but pupils are asked to bring them on their allocated day to hand to the nursing team. If your child did not receive their vaccination form, please contact the school office. We will be in touch closer to the dates above with more information.

Scottish Child Payment

Scottish Child Payment applications will open to eligible children under the age of 16 from Monday 14th November. The payment will also increase from £20 to £25 a week for each child from this date. If you already receive Scottish Child Payment, you don't need to reapply. The payment will continue as long as your remain eligible. If your child has turned 6 and is under 16, you will need to reapply when applications open on Monday 14th November. You can't apply before this date. Pupil Absence

A reminder that if your child is unwell or has an appointment and is unable to attend school, please telephone the school office on **01592 583408** and select **option 1** for the attendance line. If the line is engaged there is a facility to leave a message. Alternatively you can send a text message to **07860 030879**, stating your child's name and the reason for the absence. If your child does not arrive to class you will receive a Groupcall message informing you of their absence.

Free School Meals

If you are on a low income, Fife Council can help you with free school meals and a school clothing grant. The school clothing grant is £120.00 per child for primary school pupils and £150.00 per child for high school pupils.

To qualify for free school meals and a school clothing grant, you must be in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support
- Job Seekers Allowance (Income Based)
- Employment and Support Allowance (Income Related)
- Child Tax Credit only with annual income below £17,005
- Child Tax Credit & Working Tax Credit with annual income below £7,920



- Support under Part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999
- Universal Credit, where monthly earned income does not exceed £660
- Long Term Incapacity Benefit (school clothing grant only)
- Widows Allowance if not in full time employment (school clothing grant only)
- Child Tax Credit & Working Tax Credit with annual income below £17,005 (school clothing grant only)
