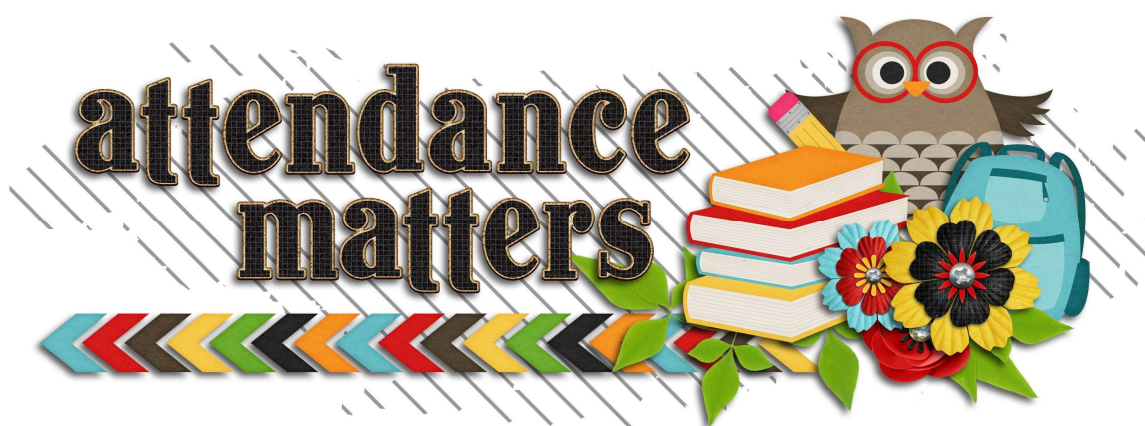
e-sgoil Study Support

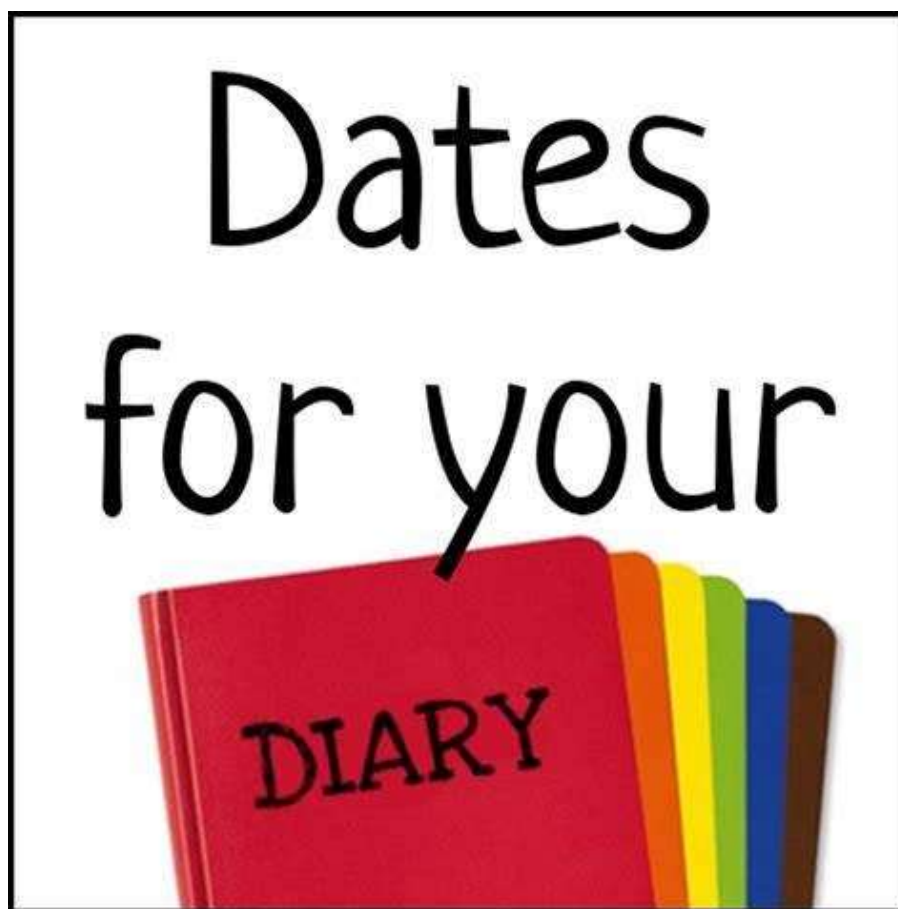
