



The courses are available for study at campuses across the region - Dunfermline, Kirkcaldy, Glenrothes, Rosyth and Levenmouth - and cover a wide range of options, from starter courses, vocational training and apprenticeships, right through to higher education and degree pathway qualifications.

Our groups worked together to solve a crime by taking part in a number of practical activities in Fife Colleges science department. Pupils collected and recorded forensic evidence at the crime scene, before learning how to handle DNA samples to identify the suspect. Our science lecturers also hosted

a forensics information session and a kahoot quiz.

All of our pupils did a fantastic job in our workshops and really seemed to enjoy the day!


We recently attended the Engineering Open Day at Rosyth campus, it was a fantastic afternoon and very informative for all those who came along!




QUEEN ANNE HS CONSTRUCTION DAY
