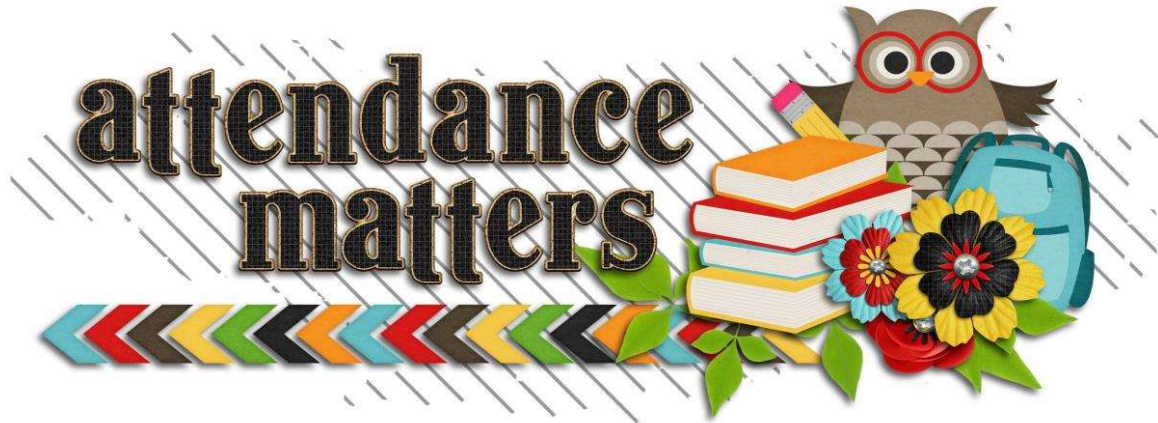

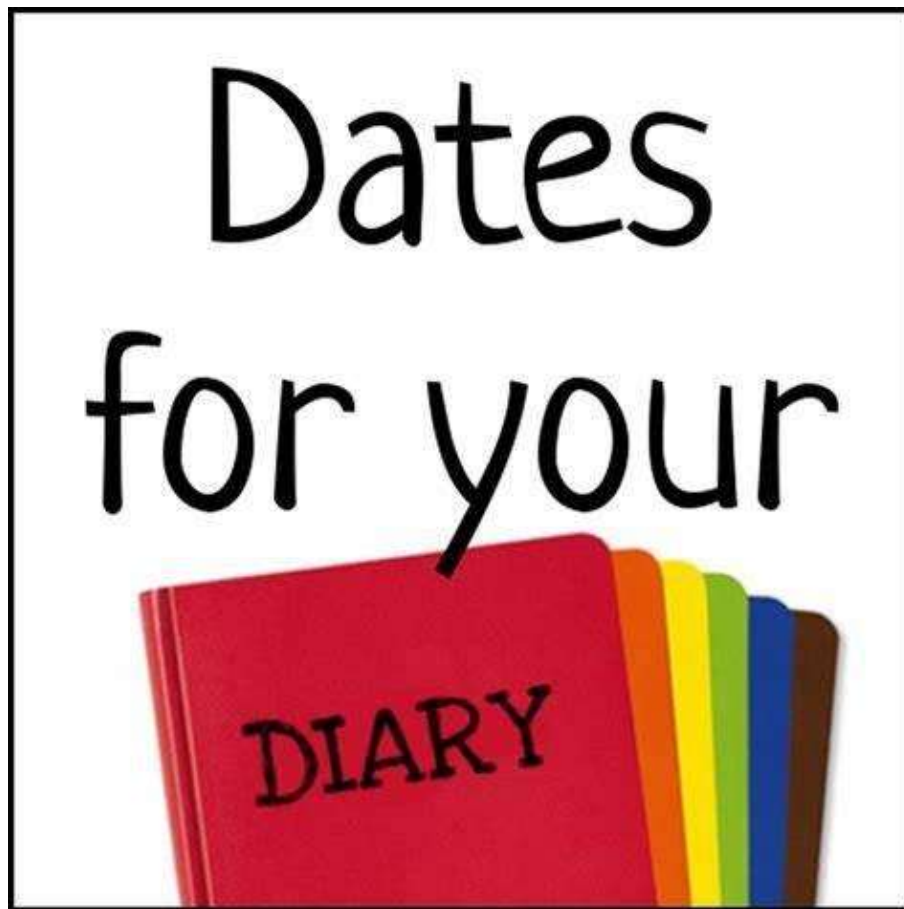
Attendance at school
