SQA Exam Preparation



To help our senior pupils who are sitting National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher exams in the coming weeks, we have a full programme of SQA Masterclasses. You can find the timetable for this on the school website and I would ask that you encourage your son or daughter to attend as this will help them to prepare for their exams.


Attendance at school
