Head Teacher Update



It's hard to believe that it's the last week of term already. The term will end at 3.10pm on Friday but all classes will be working up to and including period 7 on Friday so please work to ensure your child has 100% attendance this week.

Our S1 pupils will receive their reports towards the end of this week and if you have any questions about the content of your child's report, please contact their Guidance Teacher in the first instance.

After the holidays we have our Senior Phase Parents' Evenings (S4-6) on Wednesday 25th and Tuesday 31st of October. Parents and carers can select their preferred evening and all appointments are made online via the online booking system. These evenings are a great opportunity to hear more about how your young person is progressing in their subjects and to learn what you can do to support their learning at home. Our Skills Development Scotland Advisor, Brian McKenna, will also be available to offer advice and support on careers and pathways beyond school. The evenings begin at 4.30pm and run until 7pm. Study Support - National E-Learning Offer



Registration is now open for the NeLO / e-Sgoil evening Study Support programme for 2023/24. The Study Support comprises live, interactive webinars focussed on Senior Phase courses. The webinars are delivered by experienced teachers and 51 different webinars are on offer each week during term time, covering all the larger subject areas and an extensive range of other subjects.

The service is focussed on delivering equitable access to all learners in Scotland and is completely free. Last session, almost all learners attending Evening Webinars rated the overall quality of their experience as excellent.

Satchel One - Show My Homework



This academic session is now in full swing and pupils are receiving regular homework to support and consolidate their learning. I wanted to remind you that the school's platform for issuing homework is 'Show My Homework' and you should have received log in details to allow you to view the homework your young person has been issued as well monitoring their completion of the tasks set.

Pupils log in by clicking 'Sign in with RM Unify' and enter Glow username and password.
Pupils should not use the 'username' log in option.

How can pupils arrange to speak with their Guidance Teacher?



At Viewforth High School, we support young people to communicate with their Guidance Teacher using an electronic system.

All young people who need to, or wish to, speak to their Guidance Teacher can make an appointment using our electronic QR Code system. Every classroom has a poster with the Guidance QR code displayed and the QR code can be scanned using a mobile device. This will take them to an online form where they can leave a note explaining what they want to talk to them about. This is automatically sent to the Guidance Teacher who will then arrange to meet with the young person. Any young person who does not have a mobile device can still make an appointment by completing a paper form available in the Support Hub and leaving it in the collection box there.

This system allows young people to get in touch with their Guidance Teacher without having to physically find them to let them know they need to speak to them. We encourage all young people to use this system whenever they need to speak to their Guidance Teacher.




