S2 into S3

- S3 will continue to be about your young person's Broad General Education
- They should start thinking about it as a two-year journey towards National qualifications by the end of S4.
- We want as many young people as possible working towards National 5 or Level 5 qualifications by the time they start S4.
- Its now time to start thinking about subjects they are interested in and what they would like to study in S3 and S4.



S2 into S3 – Course Choice

- Pupils will choose 7 subjects to study in S3.
- These will be the **same** 7 subjects that they will continue to study into S4.
- Everyone will study English and Maths (then have free choice for the other 5 subjects).
- Pupils are going to have lots of subjects to choose from but they should try to think about how they can progress within the subjects they choose
- Some subjects are only offered up to N5/L5, so there won't be the option to move on to H/L6 in S5/S6.

Things to consider and who can help? (Pupils)

General Advice (Pupils)

- Consider what you might want to do in the future
- You will likely be studying some of your chosen subjects S3-S6
- Enjoyment/Ability in the subject
- Give yourself options (choose a variety of subjects – keep your options open)
- Don't just choose a subject because your friends are picking it
- Some of you might not know what you want to do yet and that's ok, if this is the case choose a variety of subjects and don't narrow your focus



Curriculum Pathway Process (Pupils)

- We want to give pupils as much choice as possible when deciding their curricular pathway
- As a school we will try to offer all the courses that they want, **but we cannot guarantee** that all courses will run (depends on – pupil uptake and staffing)
- When pupils are making their choices, they can only select a subject once



Parents/Carers

Information will be sent home to your parents/carers regarding:

- Course choice process
- Copy of this PowerPoint
- Links to course choice videos
- Recommended subjects based on attainment to date and pupil free course choice (mock – carried out in December)
- Course choice form will be completed during the meeting with DHT and Guidance Teacher and details of pupil choices will be sent home to parents and carers.
- Parents/Carers will be notified via email if any changes are being made from the original choice

Course Choice Meeting

- One to one meeting held with pupils and (SLT and PTG)
- Prior to the meeting subject recommendations will be sent home to parents and carers, outlining subjects we feel your young person will have the best chance of enjoying success (based on all the data we have to date).
- Each meeting will last 10 mins.
- Ask pupils to take time to go through their recent tracking reports and think about information obtained at parents evening when deciding on the subjects they have the best chance of success in.
